Overview

The Mohare Danda Trek is a short trek that takes trekkers into the heart of the Annapurna

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region. With the beautiful Annapurna Mountains towering over the valley, the trek by Himalaya Land Treks is a glamorous journey. It has trails traversing through Annapurna's verdant alpine woods and ethnic settlements of the indigenous Gurung and Magar people.

Mohare Danda view trek is a short trip that allows trekkers to experience the ivory peaks of the Annapurna range without an extensive trekking journey. It is a perfect trek for people who are looking for a subdued trekking adventure in the beautiful Annapurna. The Mohare Danda Trek presents panoramic views of many natural landmarks.

Trekking to Mohare Danda is an unadulterated environment blessed with natural virtues. Thick woodlands and lush forests of alpine trees like the rhododendron and birch with juniper hamlets makes trekking a peaceful event where you can lift your spirits.

The trek heads west through numerous Gurung and Magar villages to reach Mohare Danda. The views of the silver mountains like Annapurna I (8091m), Hiunchuli (6441m), Dhaulagiri (8167 m), Gangapurna (7454 m), Machhapuchhre (6997 m), and the Annapurna Range are dramatically presented in this trek. Mohare Danda Trek explores the unexplored areas of the Annapurna region.

What are the major attractions of Mohare Danda trek?

Divine Pokhara City

City of lakes-Pokhara offers you heart catching view of nature. It is a popular tourist hub where you can relax and enjoy your holidays. The reflection of beautiful Macchapuchhre on the silence of Fewa Lake makes you speechless. The Mysterious caves, rushing springs and many more take your heart here at Pokhara. It is a place of nature with a preserved culture. Everyone must visit this place at least once in a lifetime. Visit this place takes away all your stress.

Ethnic villages

The Mohare Danda trekking takes you to the many ethnic villages of the Annapurna region. This trek offers you with immense beauty of nature. A hilly lifestyle with Himalayan views is given to trekkers by this trek. You trek to Ghandruk, the largest Gurung settlement and the best

place to discover their culture. You pass through many beautiful villages like Baskharka, Ghandruk, Mohare, Nangi, Deurali etc. You are welcomed with a warm gesture by the different community with their own culture.

Mohare Danda

Mohare Danda is located at an altitude of 3300 m. It provides the closest views of Annapurna and Dhaulagiri massif. This hill station is very famous among trekkers because of the stunning views of nature seen from here. Mohare Danda offers you also get to see amazing views of the Himalayas, dramatic sky and lush green hills covered in clouds. From here you are presented with breath-taking views of the Annapurna range like the Annapurna I (8091m), Annapurna II (7937m), Annapurna South (7219m), Machhapuchhre (6997m), Dhaulagiri (8167m), Gangapurna (7454m), Hiunchuli (6441m), and the Pisang Peak (6091m) among others.

What is the best time to do Mohare Danda trek?

Spring (February- May) is the best time to do Mohare Danda Trek. The autumn period (September – December) is also a good time to make this trek. Monsoon and winter are never recommended to proceed for trekking due to slippery route way and foggy weather respectively.

Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Kathmandu |1300 meters/4265ft|

Accommodation: Overnight at 3 star Hotel

You may arrive in Kathmandu at any time. Upon your arrival at the airport, you will be met by a Himalaya Land Treks' representative who will help you get transferred to your Hotel.

Overnight stay at the Hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 2: Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara by bus. |820 meters/2690ft|7-8 hours

Accommodation: Overnight at 3 star Hotel | **Meal:** Breakfast

Today, you will be driving to Pokhara from Kathmandu. The drive takes about 6 to 7 hours and passes by the countryside where you can see amazing views of terrace farms and vast fields of mustard. The drive also passes alongside the Trishuli River and gives you the chance to catch fleeting glimpses of the country-side life of Nepal. Upon arriving in Pokhara, you will be taken to your hotel for check-in. Overnight stay at the hotel in Pokhara.

Day 3: Drive from Pokhara to Galeshwor by bus |3-4 Hrs and trek to Bans Kharka |1525 meters/5003ft| 3-4 hours

Walking hr: 7-8 hrs | **Accommodation:** Lodge/tea house | **Meal:** Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

You will be taking a bus from Pokhara to the Galeshwor village. It takes about 4 hours of driving to reach the village. Along the way, you can see amazing views of the Annapurna Mountains and the winding trail also trudges alongside the valley's ridgeline. From Galeshwor, you will begin your trek to Bans Kharka- a small ethnic settlement that is surrounded by beautiful emerald bamboo forest. Overnight stay at the guesthouse at Bans Kharka.

Day 4: Trek from Bans Kharka to Nangi |2300 meters/7546ft|5-6 hours

Walking hr: 5-6 hrs | **Accommodation:** Lodge/tea house | **Meal:** Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

Today, you will be trekking from Bans Kharka to the village of Nangi, following the trail that winds along the thick woodlands. The view of peaks like the Annapurna (8091m) and Mt. Machhapuchhre (6997m) standing tall from the valley's extremities are quite brilliant. The trek is mostly an up-and-downhill journey that goes through small settlements along with the way



and terrace farms of rice and barley. Overnight stay at the guesthouse at Nangi.

Day 5: Trek from Nangi to Mohare Danda |3300 meters/10827ft| 6-7 hours

Walking hr: 6-7 hrs | **Accommodation:** Lodge/tea house | **Meal:** Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

From Nangi, you will be making your way to the vantage point of Mohare Danda today. A marvelous hill situated between the Annapurna and the Dhaulagiri Peaks, Mohare Danda lies about 3 kilometers away from the famous vantage point of Poon Hill. Mohare Danda offers closer views of the mountains like the Nilgiri Himal (7061m), the Annapurna South (7219m), Annapurna I (8091m), Hiunchuli (6441m), and Dhaulagiri (8167m) among many others from the hill. It is also notable for its sunrise view amidst the peaks. Overnight stay at the guesthouse at Mohare Danda.

Day 6: Trek from Mohare Danda to Deurali |3090 meters/10138ft| 6 hours

Walking hr: 6 hrs | **Accommodation:** Lodge/tea house | **Meal:** Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

Waking up early, you will see the beautiful sunrise amidst the mountain peaks; the phenomenon is quite breath-taking as the rays of the sun change the tincture of the silver mountains to that of cascading molten gold. After breakfast, you will then make your way to another prominent Gurung village of the valley- Deurali, making your way through a mostly downhill trail that passes by amazing woodlands and open pastures. Overnight stay at the guesthouse at Deurali.

Day 7: Trek from Deurali to Ghandruk |1940 meters/6365ft| 6-7 hours

Accommodation: Lodge/tea house | **Meal:** Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

Ghandruk is a beautiful village that is famous for its views of the mountain peaks. The cobblestones village is filled with traditional houses and is known for its Himalayan ambiance, with cattle and yaks dallying about. The trek from Deurali to Ghandruk is peaceful and the daring mountain peaks keep you company all the way. At Ghandruk, you can indulge in observing the culture of the Gurung community and visit the local Gurung Museum. Overnight stay at the guesthouse at Ghandruk.

Day 8: Trek from Ghandruk to Nayapul|3-4 hours and drive to Pokhara |820

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meters/2690ft|1.5 hours

Walking hr: 5-6 hrs | **Accommodation:** Overnight at 3 star Hotel | **Meal:** Breakfast/Lunch

From Ghandruk, you will make your way to the small town of Nayapul. From there, you will catch a bus back to Pokhara, enjoying the ride as the bus winds along the valley ridgeline and drives along with terrace farms and roadside settlements along the way. Overnight stay at the Hotel in Pokhara.

Day 9: Drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu by bus |1300meters/4265ft| 6-7 hours | Farewell Dinner |

Walking hr: 6-7 hrs | **Accommodation:** Overnight at 3 star Hotel | **Meal:** Breakfast/Farewell Dinner

You will bid the mountain peaks goodbye for the last time today as you make your way back to the capital. Upon your arrival back in Kathmandu, you will be dropped off at your Hotel. In Kathmandu, you can shop for souvenirs or relax for the rest of the day. At the end of the way, you will participate in a farewell dinner hosted by the Himalaya Land Treks. Overnight stay at the hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 10: Transfer to airport for your final departure

Meal: Breakfast

Approximately three hours before your scheduled flight, you will be dropped off at the airport from where you will depart.

- Fresh seasonal fruits after dinner.

- All accommodation during the trek (Soft, comfort, private room with shared toilet).
- A comprehensive First Aid kit.
- All government and local taxes.
- Souvenir: Himalaya Land treks t-shirt and Trekking Route map.
- Farewell dinner at one of the finest Nepalese Restaurant with traditional ethnic music and dance.
